**To be selected interested applicants will:**

1. Attend Student Induction/Information session on the specified date
2. Complete the Upfront Assessment of Need which includes the following:
  - Supervised Core Skills Profile Assessment to assess literacy and numeracy levels meet the required Australian Core Skills Framework
  - Attend an interview with an industry employer or Limestone Coast Training representative to determine suitability, interest and availability for employment in the industry
  - Complete a Participant Agreement Form & a Limestone Coast Training Enrolment Form

**Selected applicants will then:**

1. Attend regular face to face training
2. Complete work placement as required

### **Concessions**
